Small Steps is a registered charity helping children with special needs, aged 6 months to four years and their families. We have 60 children attending sessions each week and more on our waiting list. All our children have a physical disability such as cerebral palsy or a genetic condition or other syndrome. We have been based at Greenmead School, SW15 for the past 14 years.



The local authority has asked us to vacate these premises asap, by December at the latest, so we need your help!

We need an empty suitable (large, accessible) premises in South West London, please let us know.

Sole use is preferable, though all reasonable (and radical) options considered.



The small print..... Our IDEAL would be a stand alone building, 2 big rooms for sessions (56m² is current class size), 2 or 3 office/parent spaces (8m² each), a kitchen/laundry room (same size should be ok), storage space, an adult toilet or two, as well as children's toilets, a buggy area and a visitors space (observation / meetings area).. and outside space & car-parking! Somewhere in South-West London!

Alternatively, just a big space that we can make our own.... around 150 - 160m². All options considered (scout huts / commercial/ studios / houses ...)
